Indoor Flying

Dallam School have provided us with the use of their sports hall for our indoor flying events. These will be held in the main sports hall at the Heversham site, each date is a Sunday and we have the hall for two hours from 5pm to 7pm on each occasion. The venue is ideal for small lightweight electric models (fixed or rotary wing) on any frequency, the only consideration is that models should not be of a size or construction that is likely to cause damage to the hall and especially the floor if it should suffer a crash.

If you don't have a suitable model there will be a selection of RTF lightweight models available for purchase from as little as £25 as well as some catapult and rubber band planes from just £5. The dates are: -
