Futaba TM-7 2.4GHz Modules

The 2.4GHz saga has raised its head again, as was detailed in the January newsletter all Futaba 2.4GHz equipment must be checked (if you need a copy of this newsletter then it can be downloaded from the KMAC website or ask for a copy to be mailed to you). In particular the TM-7 module should be checked to ensure that it has an inspection sticker added. This is a round silver sticker with a black printed 'I' (as in the picture below right) if your module has this sticker then it has been checked and is ok to use.



However if your module is like the one on the left then it **MUST NOT BE USED** and should be returned to Ripmax for a free exchange, the address is: -
